
Other Matters presented to the Board by TMU General Manager Jim Ankrum:

- Sewer Use Ordinance: An update is in progress and TUSB Resolution will be presented at the Apr 6 TUSB meeting for approval and recommendation for City Common Council to adopt the updated SUO
- Project Updates:
 - New LS pumps on order, expected installation in Spring 2026
 - Car Wash: Still awaiting response from previous Owner of Swity property to see if a viable option
 - New Speedway at Campbell Crossing: Contractor bidding in progress
 - West WTP Filter Bottoms, working with Vendors for quotes
 - City 12-acre property, updated Plans provided to TMU and under evaluation for optimal utility connection points
 - County Stroup Property Development on CR 560 W, no new news
 - Jefferson St LPA Grant project: TMU is involved in Design Review meetings. The City recently was awarded the Phase II project (from Independence east to SR 19) which will be completed in late 2020's and early 2030's.
 - East WWTP Clarifier Replacement, no new news

 - SE Quadrant and Stellantis Factory, no new news
